# MANIPUR



In Manipur, World Environment Day was beautifully observed across three project villages: Teiseng, Tuinom, and Songpi, in Manipur. A total of 53 students including staff and village volunteers enthusiastically participated in the event across the three villages.

Each student planted 20 saplings, organized into groups responsible for their care. Children were motivated to take pride in their responsibilities, where these groups took on tasks including regular watering, protection from pests, and prevention of damage - reinforcing their commitment to a greener future.

## International Day Against Drug Abuse





Oasis India's Kalyanapuram children and Blue Edge students took to the streets to raise awareness about the ill effects of drug abuse as we observed International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking in Chennai.

Around 70 students gathered in SM Nagar Park for an enlightening session, where Mr. Sharan, a Clinical Psychologist, explained different types of drugs, addiction, and related diseases.

We also had two child counselors from DCPU Chennai share insights on how drug abuse impacts children today.

## WORLD DAY AGAINST CHILD LABOR



In Mumbai, 59 children from our program, along with our dedicated staff, walked through Santhosh Bhavan. Holding placards with messages like "Eradicate Child Labor" "Save the Future of the Children" and "Give Children Their Rights," on World Day Against Child Labor. The day witnessed impacting 400 individuals directly and reaching another 1,200 indirectly.



In Bangalore we organized a session at Sri Vidhyaganapathi primary school, bringing awareness of the plight of child laborers worldwide. 16 boys, 16 girls, and 3 teachers took part and all held placards on the streets to spread awareness to the public. Meanwhile, at HGH 36 (16 boys and 20 girls) ASP children attended the World Day against child labor session.






In Chennai, Oasis India hosted a fantastic Summer Camp where over 80 participants from our ASP, Sports program, and local community joined in the fun!


