At just 23 years old, Nisha Chauhan found herself at a tough point in her life. Since she was nine, she had been through a traumatic experience that left her feeling alone and lost, with no one to talk to or support her.

But everything changed when she met the team from Oasis India during a community survey. They offered her a chance to learn hair and beauty skills, and Nisha saw a ray of hope. She joined the training program and, for the first time in years, found a sense of happiness. Nisha worked hard, practicing her new skills at home, and soon she started to get orders for beauty treatments and hair styling. This was the beginning of her journey to financial independence.

But Nisha's transformation wasn't just on the outside. Through Life Skill workshops and counseling sessions, she slowly rebuilt her confidence and self-esteem. The support and encouragement she received helped her believe in a brighter future.

After finishing her training, Nisha got a job at a beauty products shop. She was so happy and, for the first time, began to look forward to a future filled with promise and opportunity.

Nisha's story is a true example of overcoming challenges and finding inner strength. She turned her life around and became a confident and capable woman, ready to face whatever comes next.

Bangalore: We teamed up with Goldman Sachs volunteers and our football stars for a fantastic day filled with friendly matches of football and cricket.



Last month, ten of our students in Churachandpur, Manipur, completed their Certificate in Computer Application course by Oasis India.




